High heat, stain & scratch resistance

Zenith surfaces are your ultimate benchtop companion, with a strong and durable design.

Although our surfaces are tough, thy are not indestructible and should still be treated with care.

While having a high heat resistance, sudden and rapid heat changes can damage your benchtop. A general rule of thumb is if it is too hot to touch, it is too hot for your new benchtop.

We recommend using a chopping board of heat trivet to place hot pots, frypans or over trays on your benchtop and never directly onto the surface.

Tips for everyday cleaning

Zenith Surfaces require minimal maintenance to keep them looking as good as new.

For everyday cleaning, simply wipe your Zenith Surface with warm soapy water and a (mild) detergent and a damp, clean cloth like the microfiber cloth contained within your care kit.

For a deeper clean, we recommend using our Stone Ambassador creme cleanser and microfiber cloth. When using our cream cleanser, apply a small amount on a clean and damp microfiber cloth and wipe your benchtop in broad passes. Try to avoid concentrated rubbing in one area to avoid any scuffs or marks.

As Zenith Surfaces polished surfaces are non-porous, they will keep their radiant and smooth look without the need for any sealing or polishing, unlike natural marbles.

How to care for your

Matte and textured finishes

Everyday polished and matte benchtop cleaning requires no more than soapy water and a clean mirofiber cloth.

To manage more stubborn marks or spills on polished beenhtops, do the following:

With the contents of your care and maintenance box, wet and wash your microfiber cloth, ensuring it is clean and free of any debris.

- 2. Place a small, twenty cent piece size drop of cream cleanser on your benchtop and wipe in small circular motions with your mircofiber cloth and create a lather.
- 3. Avoid heavy rubbing in the same area to prevent any etch or scruff marks appearing.
- Once the area is clean, wipe excess cleanser away with a wet and clean mircofiber cloth or paper towel.

Cleaning your Zenith Surfaces matt or textured surfaces

- Clean using a non-scratch scouring pad and your Stone Ambassador creme cleanser
- 2. Wipe in a circular motion, avoid excess pressure.
- Wipe dry with a clean microfiber cloth.

General tips for using your Zenith Surfaces benchtops

- l. Always use a chopping board when chopping food to avoid any unwanted scratches.
- If you pots and pans are too hot to touch, they are too hot for your benchtop.
 Always use heat trivets or chopping boards to place hot items directly on your benchtop surface.
